



Greetings from Emergency Operations Centre (EOC), BDRCS.

The Emergency Operations Centre (EOC), Bangladesh Red Crescent Society (BDRCS) remains open and operational. The team is actively collecting and sharing information as required.

- **As of 6:00 PM today, no significant incidents or crises have been reported.**
- The EOC will continue operating 24/7. If any incident occurs overnight, an update will be published tomorrow at 10:00 AM. Otherwise, the second update will be shared tomorrow at 6:00 PM.
- The EOC no (01811458547) remains open 24/7 to provide necessary support.
- The BDRCS Hotline (16226) is operational from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM. A total of six (06) calls were received today. All related to blood information. The team provided the required information accordingly. **No election-related calls were received.**
- The Deputy Secretary General, along with Directors (particularly DR, Health, Youth & Volunteers, and Blood), Colleagues from IFRC and ICRC, the BDRCS Response, OSV and Communications teams, and Unit Officers remain engaged in EOC activities. Relevant information is being shared through the designated WhatsApp coordination group.
- **Health:** All BDRCS hospitals (particularly Dhaka, Chattogram, Barishal, Sylhet) and health facilities have been instructed to remain prepared to provide emergency medical support as needed, in alignment with Government directives.
- **Blood Programme:** All nine (09) BDRCS Blood Centers across the country remain operational and provides necessary services as required. **One ambulance is on standby at the Dhaka Red Crescent Blood Centre.**
- **Other Situation of Violence (OSV):** Under the OSV, the team is actively connected with field teams. **A total of 79 First Aid (FA) teams, (each comprising 07 trained Red Crescent Youth (RCY) members, totaling 553 volunteers) are on standby nationwide to provide necessary support.** The teams are fully prepared for deployment tomorrow.

- An online meeting with First Aid teams (NHQ) was held today to provide necessary instructions and guidance.
- One RCY focal person has been assigned to each of the 68 Units where the Unit Officer is currently out of station.
- Coordination is ongoing with Units and, where necessary, with the Deputy Commissioner (DC) in the districts.
- The Election Commission has approved BDRCS First Aid activities and has shared official letters with relevant Government authorities.
- All the activities are ongoing as per the **Contingency Plan for Addressing Potential Crisis During the National Election** which was shared earlier.
