



The Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) ,BDRCS remains open and operational for the National Election. The team is actively collecting and sharing information as required:

- **As of 6:00 PM today, no major incidents or crises have been reported. However, several minor incidents have been recorded (details attached in the Excel sheet).**

**Injuries: A total of 120 individuals were reported injured across 17 districts** ( Meherpur 23, Noakhali 21, Bagerhat 19, Lakshmipur 12, Pabna 8, Cumilla 7, Chattogram 6, Bhola 4, Kishoreganj 4, Dinajpur 4, Gopalganj 3, Bogra 3, Jeshore 2, Barguna 1, Feni 1, Munshiganj 1, Netrokona 1).

**Fatalities:** A total of 10 deaths were reported, of which 9 were to natural causes

**Note:** *The above information has been compiled by the EOC team from various media sources. Additionally, some cases were communicated to us by our Unit Level Officers (ULOs).*

- **First Aid (FA): Approximately 32 injured individuals received first aid services** from deployed teams in Rajshahi, Chattogram, Dhaka, Sherpur, Barishal, Shariatpur, Meherpur, Rajbari, Nilphamari, Chapainawabganj, and several other districts.

During the deployment, First Aid (FA) Teams gathered incident-related information from reliable sources and provided necessary medical assistance as required.

In total, **80 FA Teams from 68 BDRCS Units** and the National Headquarters (NHQ) were deployed, engaging **approximately 554 trained RCY volunteers**. A consolidated and final report will be shared accordingly upon receipt from all Units through Kobo.

- **Coordination Update: Two coordination meetings were held today.** The meetings were attended by the Secretary General, Deputy Secretary General, Head of Delegation (IFRC), Head of Delegation (ICRC), Director – Disaster Response , Youth and Volunteers, Communications, along with colleagues from IFRC, ICRC, the EOC team, and FA team.

During the meetings, participants shared updates, provided guidance, and discussed ongoing response activities and forward planning.

The next coordination meeting is scheduled for tomorrow at 11:30 AM.

- The EOC will continue operating 24/7. If any incident occurs overnight, an update will be published tomorrow at 10:00 AM. Otherwise, the second situation update will be shared tomorrow at 6:00 PM.

The EOC no (01811458547) remains open 24/7 to provide necessary support.

- The BDRCS Hotline (16226) is operational from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM. **No election-related calls were received, except for two (02) inquiries regarding blood availability.**
- **Health:** All BDRCS hospitals ( particularly Dhaka, Chattogram, Barishal, Sylhet) are functional as per the contingency plan.
- **Blood Programme:** All nine (09) BDRCS Blood Centres across the country remain operational and provides services as required. **One ambulance is on standby at the Dhaka Red Crescent Blood Centre.**
- All the activities are ongoing as per the **Contingency Plan for Addressing Potential Crisis During the National Election** which was shared earlier.
