



3rd Situation Update on the National Election 2026 in Bangladesh.

The Emergency Operations Centre (EOC), BDRCS, remains operational in response to the National Election and continues to monitor and share relevant information as required:

As of 6:00 PM today, no major incidents or crises have been reported. However, several minor incidents have been recorded following post-poll clashes in different locations across Bangladesh (details are provided in the attached Excel sheet)

- **Injuries: A total of 79 individuals were reported injured across 06 districts** (Patuakhali 30, Jhenaidah 25, Kishoreganj 10, Bagerhat 10, Meherpur 03, Jashore 01).

Fatalities: No deaths have been reported.

Note: *The above information has been compiled by the EOC team from various media sources.*

- **First Aid (FA):** Today, **07 First Aid (FA) teams** comprising 49 trained RCY members (seven per team) were deployed in Dhaka City, Chattogram City, Chattogram District, Rajshahi City, Cox's Bazar, Khulna City, and NHQ. **No First Aid services were required.**
- **Coordination Update: One coordination meeting was held today in the morning.** The meetings were attended by the Deputy Secretary General, Head of Delegation (IFRC), Head of Delegation (ICRC), Director – Youth and Volunteers, Communications, along with colleagues from IFRC, ICRC, the EOC team, and FA team.

Decision for future action: Organize a lessons-learned workshop on the electoral deployment and strengthen EOC capacity for verification and information management.

- The EOC team will continue to closely monitor the post-poll situation and promptly share any significant updates. The EOC number (01811458547), including WhatsApp, remains operational.
- The BDRCS Hotline (16226) operates from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM. **No election-related calls were received**, except for three inquiries regarding blood availability and training. The hotline will remain operational tomorrow.
- **Health:** All BDRCS hospitals (particularly Dhaka, Chattogram, Barishal, Sylhet) are functional as per the contingency plan.

- **Blood Programme:** All nine (09) BDRCS Blood Centers across the country remain operational and provide services as required. **One ambulance is on standby at the Dhaka Red Crescent Blood Centre.**
- All activities are ongoing in accordance with the previously shared Contingency Plan for Addressing Potential Crises during the National Election.
